 - Love the Lord with all your heart and soul (spiritual)
 - Love your neighbour as yourself (relational)
- Deuteronomy 8:4-5
 - The *Shema*: (shu-MAH) The central prayer of Judaism, proclaiming God is one
 - *Me'od*: strength; much or very (muchness)
 - Genesis 1:30 God refers to his creation as good six times and then says it's *me'od* good
 - Genesis 4:15 Cain is *me'od* angry at his brother
- Changing some things didn't compromise Daniel's faith
 - Clothing
 - Language
 - Education
- Daniel resolved not to defile himself by:
 - Eating food that had been sacrificed to idols
 - Making a public declaration of his dependence on the king rather than on God
- The story of Daniel reminds us that kings and courts and earthly authorities do not have the final word

• God gives us the strength we need because God is right there with us – He will never leave us
