  - · Paul's awkward fundraising
  - eulogia: blessing (good words)

• 2 Corinthians 9: 6-11 (Paul moves from the practical to the theological)

- Remember this: NOT "name it and claim it, call it and haul it" (verse 6)
  - Seek ye FIRST the Kingdom
- Verse 7: Give what you have decided; not reluctantly or compulsory but cheerful
  - Wesley: gain all you can; give all you can
  - hilaros: cheerful (hilarious giving)
- Verses 8-10: God is able and will provide
- Verse 11: the promise
  - You WILL BE enriched SO THAT you can be generous on every occasion (having all that you need, you will abound in every good work)
