Verbs from the Vineyard

JOHN 15:1-8



John 15 (NRSV)

'I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine-grower. 2 He **removes** every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that **bears fruit** he **prunes** (*kathairó*) to make it bear more fruit. 3 You have already

been **cleansed** (*katharos*) by the word that I have spoken to you. 4 **Abide** (*menó*) in me as I abide in you. Just as the branch cannot bear fruit by itself unless it abides in the vine, neither can you unless you abide in me. 5 I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing. 6 Whoever does not abide in me is thrown away like a branch and withers; such branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. 7 If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples.
