Unless you choose to share it with others, the only people who will see this survey will be Pastors Tasha and Steve, so fill out without embarrassment, safe in the knowledge that you are valued and loved. ## GIFTS

It is clear from the Scriptures that the Gifts of the Spirit are given to the believer by God. These are not human-powered, human-made gifts but ones which can only be given and empowered by the Spirit of God in the life of the believer.

The Holy Spirit, who is given by Jesus in His absence, is:

- the One who will guide us into truth (John 16:13);
- the One who will give us words to speak (Luke 12:12);
- the One who reminded the disciples of Jesus' teachings (John 14:26);
- the One through whom we as believers receive the love of God (Romans 5:5);
- the One who groans for us expressing that which we cannot express (*Romans 8:26*).

As the people of God, we are each allotted the gifts of the Spirit that we are called to exercise in ministries that work for the common good (*1 Corinthians 12*). It is the Spirit who empowers those activities, and not we ourselves.

The gifts (as seen in *Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10; 28-30* and *Ephesians 4:11*) which are considered as part of this survey are as follows:

- Administration a follower with this gift helps to lead the body of Christ by steering others to remain on task. Administration helps the church to organise according to their God-given purposes and long-term goals, paying attention to the "small details" which could have a great impact.
- **Apostleship** a follower with this gift motivates the church to look beyond its walls in order that they might carry out the Great Commission. Those with this gifting are visionary and often grasp the bigger picture, bringing it to the forefront of the church's thinking.
- **Discernment** the Holy Spirit gives the gift of discernment to enable certain Christians to clearly recognise and distinguish the influences of God, Satan, the world, and the flesh in any given situation.
- **Evangelism** given the unique ability by the Holy Spirit, those with this gift are burdened in their heart for the lost and will go out of their way to share the truth of Christ with them. Their ability to relate to a variety of different groups allows them to engage others in meaningful conversations about the things of God.
- **Exhortation** a follower with this gift has the the heart of encouragement. They encourage others to be involved in and enthusiastic about doing the good works God has prepared for them to do. Individuals with this gifting make for good counsel.
- **Faith** a follower with this gift encourages and builds up the church in its confidence in God. Those with this gift trust that God is sovereign and good, take Him at His Word and come to him with expectant hearts in prayer--and are not surprised whenever He answers. They often follow God's leading when it does not make earthly sense to do so.
- **Giving** this gift is imparted to some in the church who meet the various needs of the church and its ministries, missionaries, or of people who do not have the means to provide fully for themselves. Those with this gift love to share the blessings that God has given to them, and are excellent stewards of their time, energy, skills, talents, and financial resources.
- **Hospitality** those with this gift have the ability to make visitors, guests, and strangers feel at ease and cared for. They often use their homes to entertain guests. These individuals care for the physical, mental, and spiritual needs of others. Individuals with this gift are a huge help in integrating new members into the body and life of the church.

- **Knowledge** people with this gift are well-versed in the Scriptures and teachings of the Church and can use this spiritual gift to bring about understanding and to inform the church or individual believers. They can retain the truth and communicate it effectively at the appropriate times, relating the truth to specific situations for specific times and circumstances.
- Leadership this gift is given to some in the church in order to care for God's people and lead them into deeper relationship with Christ and each other. Those with this gift are to accomplish many different tasks and objectives as they lead, but will always lead relationally and with deep concern for the spiritual well-being of others. They are "visionary" and tend not to get caught up too much in the detail.
- **Mercy** followers with this gift love and assist those who are suffering, and walk with them until the Lord allows for their burden to be lifted; they feel the need to simply "be there" for others. This gift is founded in God's mercy toward us and is consistently expressed with compassion. Those with this gifting are sensitive to the feelings of others and can quickly discern whenever someone is not doing well.
- **Prophecy** this gift is not always about sharing new words from God, but is often about making God's heart known and building up the Church by proclaiming His Word boldly. This proclamation will often lead to conviction of sin. Those with this gift are sensitive to both the prompting of the Holy Spirit and to the needs of the local church body, humbly studying the Scriptures and seeking counsel in order to test any revelations before speaking them. Those with this gift are always motivated by love for God and neighbour.
- Service/Helps a follower with this gift is committed to the spread of Gospel and serves in ways that benefit others with different gifts and ministries that are more public. Those with this gift do not seek recognition or a position in the "spotlight," but simply love to help in the background, knowing that their contribution will bless the church, display the love of Christ to the world, and bring glory to God.
- **Shepherding** first and foremost servants, those with the gift of shepherding care for the spiritual well-being of others in the church by drawing alongside them and walking through life's hills and valleys with them. They also rely heavily on the Scriptures for guidance in these matters, and have the trust and respect of those they are drawing alongside. Those with this gifting exercise it with humility and service as they are reminded daily of their overwhelming need of God's grace and Spirit to enable them for the task at hand.
- **Teaching** without this gift, the church would quickly fall into error and sin. Those with this gifting recognise when Scripture is misinterpreted or church teaching is misused or abused for selfish gain, and because they love the truth, they speak the truth in love. Those with this gift seek particularly to fully love the Lord with all their minds. They are called to demonstrate God's love while revealing His truth to the world without fear; an outcome of their exercising their gifting is that the church grows in Christlikeness and spiritual maturity.
- **Wisdom** followers with this gift have a deep understanding of the holiness of God and the need for holiness in their own hearts. They have compassion and boldness in sharing with others this truth in their lives. Those with this gift can often see through the confusion of a situation and give direction to help ensure glory is brought to God.

Gifts which are NOT included in this survey, but which we affirm as Spiritual Gifts found in Scripture, are the Gifts of Healing, Interpretation, Miracles and Tongues.
